FutureCare is the **largest provider of skilled ventilator services** in the state of Maryland featuring 157 ventilator beds in four facilities in our specialized **Progressive Pulmonary Care Units**.

Short-term management – When appropriate, we actively wean residents from the ventilator and the tracheostomy tube.

Long-term management – For residents with diagnoses that make ventilator dependency a part of their lives, we offer extended ventilator management services combined with traditional long term care services.

- **Respiratory Therapists are on-site 24/7**
- **Registered Nurses on-site 24/7**
- **Consulting Pulmonologists**
- **Physical, Occupational and Speech Therapists** (both bedside and in the gym)
- **Wound nurses and wound team** in all facilities
- **Recreational therapy** for ventilator patients
- Designated **social services** with patient and family education
- End of life options include palliative and hospice care with a full-time Chaplin on staff
- For consistency and quality of care FutureCare owns and operates the Respiratory Therapy Division

Cutting Edge Technology

- All ventilator units have piped in O2 and in-wall suction systems.
- All ventilator units are equipped with auxiliary ventilator alarm system.
- We use portable “ICU type” ventilators - LTV 1200 on all ventilator units. This allows our ventilator patients to leave the unit to attend therapy, go outside with family, and other activities as tolerated and appropriate.
- Each P2CU vent unit has back-up generator systems in the event of prolonged commercial power outage (specific to that unit).
- Non-Invasive CPAP and BiPAP.
- Pulse oximetry and end tidal CO2 monitoring.
- Care plans designed for each individual. Care teams meet regularly to discuss, evaluate for effectiveness and modify plans to ensure the highest quality of care is given at all times.
